The Ottawa County Commissioners, acting upon the recommendation of the Ottawa County Soil & Water Conservation District as required by the Ohio Revised Code sections 940, will hold a final hearing regarding the proposed drainage improvement **Mehlow Ditch Project**. You are receiving this letter as official notification that your property has been identified as benefitting from this project.

The Board of Ottawa County Commissioners has set October 2, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. at the Ottawa County Commissioners' Assembly Room, 315 Madison Street, Room 103, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452, as the date for the final hearing.

Property owners may file comments on the proposed improvement, exceptions to the estimated assessment, and information on their drainage system in writing before September 25, 2025, or in person at the final hearing. Those who wish to file written comments may send them to the Ottawa County Commissioners, 315 Madison Street, Room 103, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

The Ottawa Soil and Water Conservation District applied for an H2Ohio Conservation Ditch Grant to assist with the cost of this project. The Ohio Department of Agriculture reviewed the application and awarded a grant to the Ottawa SWCD. The grant funds will be used to help offset the cost of the project, thereby reducing the amount benefitting property owners will be required to pay.
