

2026 Agriculture and Natural Resources Scholarship

<u>Purpose</u> - To promote the education of Ottawa County students planning to pursue a degree in agriculture, natural resources or a related field.

Qualifications - Applications will be accepted from students meeting the following criteria:

- 1. Either a 2026 graduating senior or a graduate that attended an *Ottawa County High School*
- 2. Enrolled for Fall 2026 as a full-time student at a two or four-year accredited college, technical school or university
- 3. Pursuing a degree in agriculture, natural resources or a related field

*** Although prior recipients are encouraged to submit an application, the Scholarship Selection Committee will take
this into consideration during their review process***

<u>Conditions of the Scholarship</u>- The Ottawa SWCD will award two (2) five hundred dollar (\$500) college scholarships to Ottawa County graduating seniors for the 2025-2026 academic year, or a past graduate. The scholarship award will be processed through the school's scholarship office and will be available to the student in May 2026.
